From Boston and all points North:

Take I95 South past Providence, then take Exit 9 from left hand lane onto Route 4 South. Route 4 turns into Route 1 South. Following Route 1 South past the Route 138 sign, take the Narragansett Exit and take a left at the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp. Go under the overpass and halfway around the rotary, following signs for Narragansett and Route 1A. Drive about a mile and take a right at the first traffic light. You will be on Kingstown Road, go half a mile and take a left at the first stop sign, then an immediate left into our parking lot.

She is the Vice-President of a family recycling business and is President for a rental property agency.
